

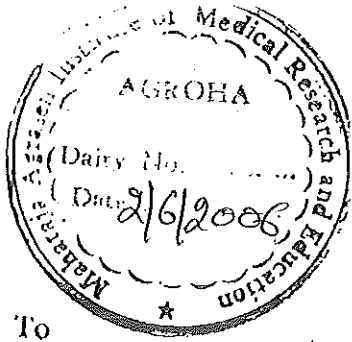

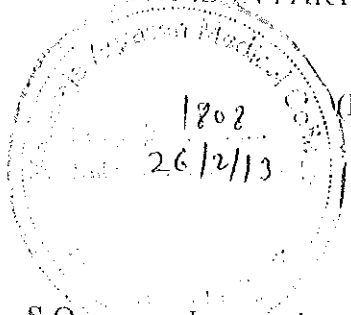

Sir/Madam,

In supersession to this Ministry's letter No.U-12012/36/2016-ME.I dated 10.06.2016 and with reference to your fresh compliance/representation submitted in light of directive dated 13.06.2016 of the Supreme Court mandated Oversight Committee (OC), I am directed to say that the OC has approved increase of intake capacity at **Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Aghroha** from 50 to 100 seats in MBBS Course for the academic year 2016-17 subject to submission of the following:-

- i. An affidavit from the Chairman of the Trust/Society/University/College etc. concerned, affirming fulfilment of all deficiencies and statements made in the respective compliance report submitted to MHFW by 22 June 2016.
 - ii. A Bank Guarantee in the amount of Rs. 2 crore in favour of MCI, which will be valid for 1 year or until the first renewal assessment, whichever is later. Such bank guarantee will be in addition to the prescribed fee submitted alongwith the application.
2. The OC has also stipulated as follows:-
- (a) OC may direct inspection to verify the compliance submitted by the college and considered by OC, anytime after 30 September 2016.
 - (b) In default of the conditions (i) and (ii) in para 1 above and if the compliances are found incomplete in the inspection to be conducted after 30 September 2016, such college will be debarred from fresh intake of students for 2 years commencing 2017-18.
3. The Central Government accordingly issues this Letter of Permission for increase of intake capacity from 50 to 100 seats in MBBS course at **Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Aghroha** for the academic year 2016-17 u/s 10A of IMC Act, 1956 subject to furnishing documents as per para 1 above alongwith another Bank Guarantee of required amount in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for five years from a Nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI Regulations 1999 for increase of intake capacity from 50 to 100 seat in MBBS Course within 15 days to this Ministry. In the event of non-submission of the affidavit and Bank Guarantees within the stipulated period, this Letter of Permission shall stand withdrawn.

4. This permission of the Central Government is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to the verification of the achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme and revalidation of performance Bank Guarantee. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure & expansion of hospital facility are completed and a formal recognition of the Medical College against increased intake is granted.
5. The next batch of students in MBBS course against increased intake for the academic session 2017-18 will be admitted in the college only after obtaining permission of Central Government and fulfilling the conditions of OC stipulated in para 2 of this letter.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
7. Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the notice of MCI and Central/State Government.

Whereas, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India vide order No.U-12012/20/2018-ME.I dated 31.05.2018 directed Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Hisar, Agroha not to admit 3rd batch of MBBS students for the academic year 2018-19 against the increased intake from 50-100;

2. Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 09.07.20108 in Writ Petition (C) No.735 of 2018 directed as under:-

"...Except for the fact that the renewal for the enhanced intake of 100 seats is for the third MBBS Course, this Writ Petition is similar to Writ Petition No.662 of 2018. Therefore, the Government of India is directed to enhance the intake of the Petitioner-College from 50 to 100 for third MBBS course for the academic year 2018-2019."

3. Now, therefore, in compliance of the above order of the Supreme Court, permission of the Central Govt. under Section 10 A of IMC Act, 1956 for admission of 3rd Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. from 50 to 100 for the academic year 2018-19 at Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Hisar, Agroha is conveyed herewith;

4. The next batch of students in 2019-20 against increased intake i.e. from 50 to 100 will be admitted only after obtaining permission from the Central Government;

5. Admissions made in violation of above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be taken as per provisions of IMC Act, 1956 & the Regulations made thereunder;

Subject: Continuation of recognition of MBBS degree granted by PT. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak in respect of students being trained at Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Agroha - regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform you that an assessment to assess the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree (50 seats) granted by PT. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak in respect of students being trained at Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Agroha was carried out by the Council's Assessors on 25th & 26th September, 2018. The said assessment report alongwith summary/observations of Member of the Undergraduate Expert Group appointed by the Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak at Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Agroha be continued restricting the number of admission to 50 (fifty) students.

The Board of Governors also decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April, 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

- (2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- (3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.
- (4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute...."

It is further to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration of fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of Recognition by the Council and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is liable not to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the annual intake capacity of 50 students and this approval is also liable to be, revoked. Besides, MCI is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

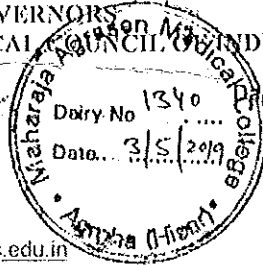

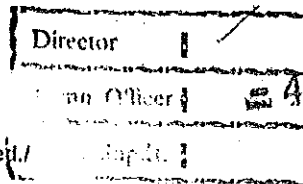
