GUIDELINES FOR ELECTIONS OF 200 ELECTORAL COLLEGES TO ELECT THE MEMBERS OF COLLEGIUM OF THE SOCIETY ALONGWITH OTHER RELEVANT DESCRIPTIONS & INFORMATIONS

1. General

The next elections of the collegium have been notified on 04.01.2021 and the list of members of the society and list of members of 200 Electoral Colleges also have been published the same day. One member each from 200 Electoral Colleges are to be elected as per Election Schedule, displayed on the Website and Notice Board of the society. Notice of the election schedule has also been sent to all the members of the society by speed post. The Guidelines of the Elections and other relevant descriptions and informations, prepared in view of the provisions of the Haryana Registration & Regulation of Societies Act and rules-2012 and bye-laws of the society, are given herein further.

2. Eligibility conditions for a candidate for election of members of Collegium (one member each from 200 Electoral Colleges), documents to be submitted alongwith nomination paper & other terms & conditions of election are as under:-

- i. A Candidate must be a member of the society and his name should exist in the list of the Electoral College from he wants to seek election.
- ii. A Candidate should not be convicted by any court of law for the offence of moral turpitude for one year or more.
- iii. If a member of the society, although his name exists in the list of Electoral Colleges, but he is an employee of the society or its institutions, he is not eligible to seek election.
- iv. A Candidate shall have to submit the nomination paper, in prescribed form, in **PERSON** himself / herself.
- v. A Member of the society can seek election from an Electoral College in which his name exists as member / voter.
- vi. A Candidate shall have to show / present his any one identity proof, in original, at the time of nomination out of Identity Card issued by the Society, if any, Electoral Identity Card, Passport, Driving License, PAN Card, Adhaar Card, Senior Citizen Card etc. and a photocopy of the same will be attached with the nomination form, duly self attested.
- vii. A Contesting candidate can appoint his election agent or polling agent from the members of the Society only, to attend the polling and counting on behalf of the candidate and no other person (other than the member of the society) can be appointed as agent.

3. Eligibility of voter & his Identification

- i) A member / voter of the society whose, name exist in the list of 200 different Electoral Colleges, shall be eligible to vote in the same Electoral College in which his / her name exists.
- ii) The voter should not be convicted by any court of law for the offence of moral turpitude for one year or more.
- iii) A member of the society, who is an employee of the society or its institutions even if his / her name exists in the list of voters / members will not be eligible to vote.
- iv) A voter shall have to show his identity proof, in original, at the time of polling, if desired by the Returning Officer / Presiding Officer or any candidate or his agent. The acceptable proofs of identity are Identity card issued by the society, if any, Electoral Identity Card, Passport, Driving License, PAN Card, Adhaar Card, Senior Citizen Card etc. However, the Returning Officer or Presiding Officer shall have the discretion to accept or reject the identity proof due to valid reasons.

4. Model Code of Conduct

Model code of conduct for a candidate shall remain in force from the date of nomination by him / her till the completion of election process. Election propaganda, if any, shall be closed at 3:00 P.M. on 27.01.2021.

5. Polling and Counting of Votes & Declaration of Results

The voters shall be allowed to cast their votes, in person. Voting shall be by secret ballot paper. The counting of the votes will be conducted in the presence of the candidates or their agents by and under the control of Returning Officer / Presiding Officer. After counting of votes the results will be declared by the Returning Officer which shall also be displayed on the notice board and website of the society. The polling & counting of votes will be under the supervision and observation of the Observer / representative of the District Registrar of Societies, if appointed by him.

Note: - After the elections of the Members of Collegium, the office bearers and members of the Governing Body will be elected by the members of the Collegium including Founder Members of the Society for which notice of elections of the Governing Body, along with schedule of election, will be sent to the members of the Collegium.
