
The information about destroying the patient records of the medical college has been given in the newspaper. So in this regard, please upload the attached agreement copy in the tender section of the college website. .



Incharge Medical Records

Agreement

1. That the above agreement is related to destruction of medical records of patients and others college records belongs to Maharaja Agrasen Medical College, Agroha
2. That the second party agrees to lift all the records from MAMC, Agroha including the medical records of patients for destruction at its own risk and responsibility.
3. That the first party will constitute a committee of minimum two officers/officials to oversee the destruction of these records.
4. That second party will destroy these records, in presence of above two officers/ Officials and will make a video recording of the same, which shall be submitted to the first party, with a letter of success fully work completion
5. In the event of any dispute and difference arising out of or in any way touching or concerning this agreement whether during the currency of this agreement or whether before or after termination, whatsoever, shall be referred for arbitration to be conducted as per the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 by the sole Arbitrator appointed mutually by both parties. The place of arbitration shall be the place at MAMC, Agroha and the award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the both parties.
6. That this agreement shall be governed by the laws of India and subject to the provisions of arbitration as contained in the agreement, the appropriate courts at Hisar or Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court at Chandigarh shall have the jurisdiction to adjudicate any dispute arising out of or in respect of the Agreement.
